Polyplectron napoleonis

- + This bird is named after the island of Palawan in the Philippines where it originally comes from
- + The bright male bird can cleverly hide in the undergrowth, by altering his body shape to blend in with his surroundings
- + This bird eats small invertebrates, seeds, fruit and berries

Red crested turaco

Tauraco erythrolophus

- + This is the national bird of Angola and is a striking red and green colour
- + Their feathers contain a colour pigment containing copper. If you stirred a glass of water with a red turaco feather, the water would turn pink!
- + Males and females are 'monomorphic', which means they both look alike

Pagoda mynah

Sturnia pagodarum

- + It is thought that this bird's name comes from their tendency to perch on temple pagodas in their native habitat
- + They can eat the fruit of the yellow oleander, a plant highly toxic to most vertebrate species
- + They are often found in dry forests and scrub jungle

Chalcopsitta duivenbodei

- + Harewood Bird Garden is one of only a few zoos in Europe where you can see this bird
- + They have a special tongues with small 'brushes' on the tip which they use to get nectar from flowers
- + Their parrot-shaped beak is used for climbing in trees to search for nectar
