- + The roul roul partridge is also known as the crested wood partridge
- + They prefer to walk or run rather than fly, and like to live in groups
- + Males and females look quite different. Males are black with a chestnut crest on top of their head, females are green with brown wings

- + These owls have long legs which are useful for running after their prey
- + They live in open grasslands and nest in underground burrows
- + In the wild, dung beetles are one of their favourite foods, it is thought they attract them by placing dung around their nest

- + Originating from India, these birds escaped from captivity and have now formed feral populations in Great Britain
- + As an invasive species, they are considered to be an agricultural pest, as well as a threat to some of our own native birds



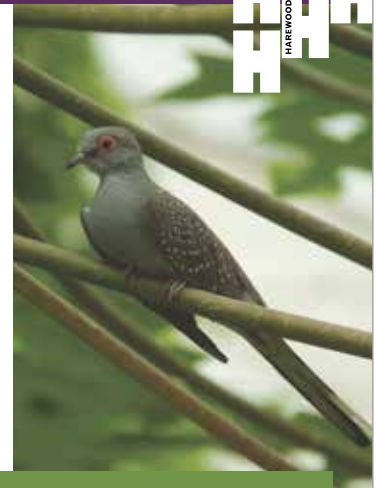

Geopelia cuneate

- + The Diamond Dove is Australia's smallest pigeon and are quite commonly kept in back garden aviaries
- + They are usually seen in pairs, sometimes forming flocks of up to 30 birds
- + They feed from the ground, eating mostly seeds as well as ants and a variety of vegetables
