- + They are very good swimmers, and can swim up to 17mph
- + They are flightless birds, but their powerful wings help power them through the water

- + These birds are heavily poached across Indonesia where they are sold as pets

- + These birds are also known as Wallich's pheasants, named after the Danish botanist Nathaniel Wallich
- + They are a fairly sociable birds and they will mate for life
- + Destruction of habitat and hunting have caused a decline in numbers of this increasingly rare bird

Madagascar partridge

Margaroperdix madagarensis



- + These birds are thought to have been introduced to Reunion Island to the East of Madagascar by humans
- + Males are a deep reddish brown, with white streaks across the face, whilst females are a dull buff colour
- + They are found in Madagascar, Reunion Island & Mauritius
