- + Although there have not been any surveys carried out on the population of this species, it is thought to be declining

- + The oldest records of caged Java sparrows date back to the Ming Dynasty (13th to 16th century) in China
- + The popularity of this finch as a caged bird has resulted in centuries of intense trapping, causing rapid decline in numbers
- + The population is now less than 2,500 individuals

- + This bird is found in the hill forests of south east China, its habitat is becoming fragmented by deforestation
- + They get their name from the white collar of feathers around their neck
- + They have a long haunting call which can be heard all the way in the Walled Garden at Harewood!

Black cheeked lovebird

Agapornis nigrigenis



- + This bird is thought to be the most endangered of all African parrots with only 10,000 left in the world
- + In 1900s they were caught in huge numbers for the pet trade
- + Unlike other birds who acquire their water from food, this lovebird needs daily access to fresh water
