- + Now a domesticated species, this bird is often found in back gardens and farms
- + They are often kept as alternatives to chickens as they are good egg producers
- + Despite their dumpy appearance Guinea fowl are strong fliers and roost in trees

Probosciger aterrimus

- + Palm cockatoos are a type of parrot native to Australia, Indonesia & Papua New Guinea
- + As of 2017 Harewood was one of only two zoos in Europe to successfully breed this species
- + Males use sticks to drum on hollow trees as a way of communicating with other palm cockatoos.

Ara ambiguus

- + It is thought that there are less than 2,500 adult birds left in the wild
- + Our male bird was part of a UK Customs seizure of birds that had been illegally smuggled from their native habitats
- + Deforestation and the pet trade are the two main threats to this species

Vasa parrot

Coracopsis vasa

- + These birds are grey with a bright white beak
- + The population is in decline, due to habitat destruction and persecution from farmers, as they feed on crops
- + Females will nest in deep hollow tree trunks. Males will provide her with food as she sits on her egg and raises her chick
