- + Males and females can be recognized by their eye colour
- + These birds are very intelligent, and excellent mimics. They are popular pets, but require lots of attention

- + Choughs are members of the corvid (crow) family. They have an red curved beak which they use for probing in the earth for insects to eat
- + Their legs are the same red colour, which makes them different to other crows
- + They are native to the UK and live in coastal areas

Lophophorus impejanus



- + This beautifully colourful pheasant is the national bird of Nepal
- + The male's feathers are a combination of 12 shimmering colours, with a head crest similar to a peacock
- + With the population in decline, these birds are hunted both for food and for their feathers

Yellow necked francolin

Pternistis leucoscepus



- + This bird is named after the bright patch of yellow skin on its neck, and is the only francolin species to have this special marking
- + They live in natural and man-made habitats and are the largest of the sub Saharan francolins
- + They spend most of their time on the ground moving between shrubs
