- + Seriema's have a high pitched call that can be heard at great distances
- + Their long legs mean they can run fast in pursuit of their dinner, which might include lizards and snakes
- + Despite being good runners they can also fly well and so will often be seen perching in trees

- + They will nest close to penguin nesting colonies and have been known to eat penguin chicks
