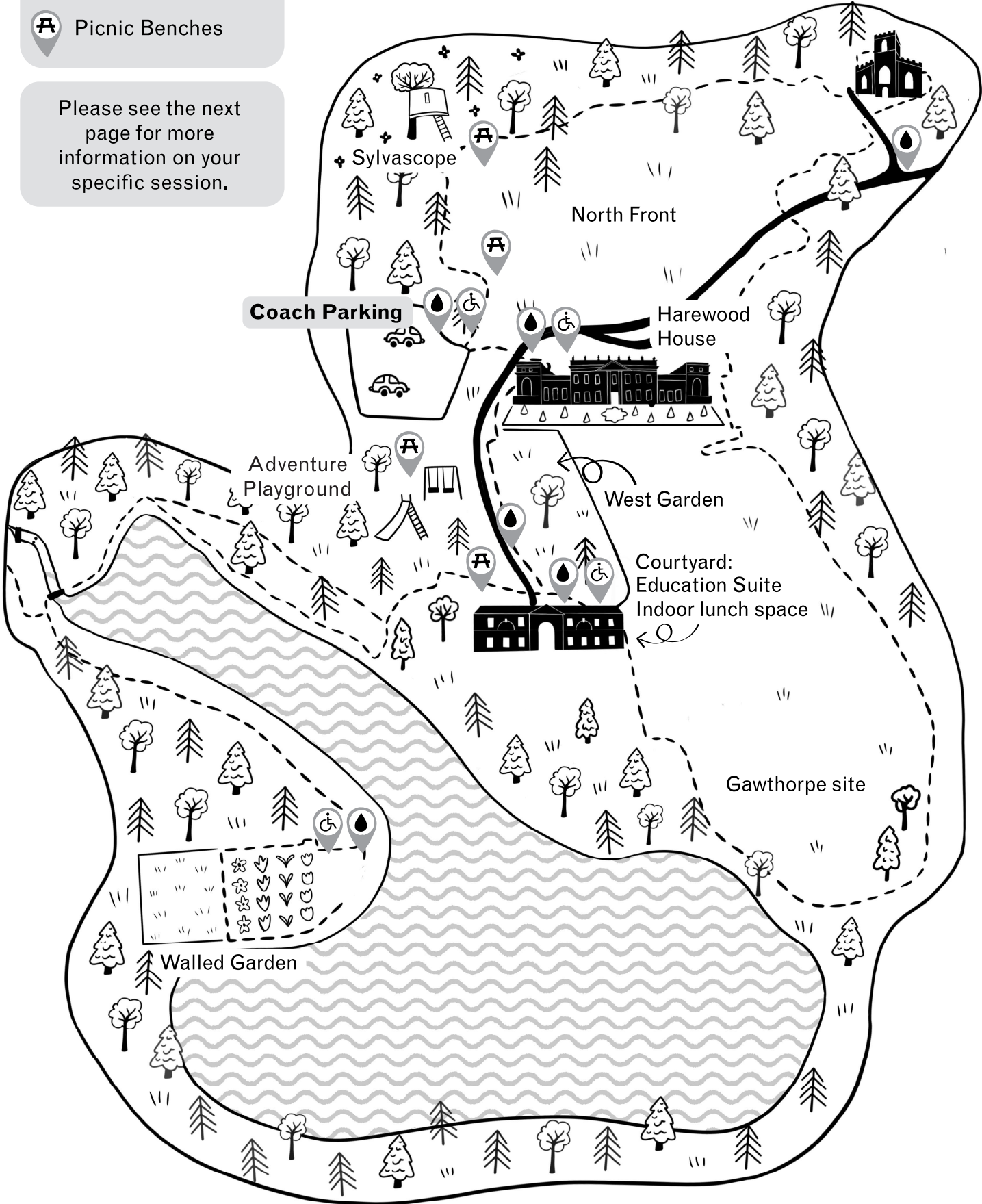

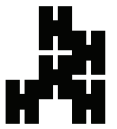

KS2 Self-Guided Itinerary

Time	Group	Activity
10.00 - 10.15	all	Arrive at Harewood and park in the Coach Park
10.15 - 10.30	all	Visit the toilets next to the Coach Park and split the class into two groups
10.30 - 11.15	1	Visit the House and complete the spot-it worksheet.
10.30 - 11.15	2	Visit the West Garden and complete the KS2 Working Scientifically worksheet
11.15 - 12.00	2	Visit the House and complete the spot-it worksheet.
11.15 - 12.00	1	Visit the West Garden and complete the KS2 Working Scientifically worksheet
12.00 - 12.30	all	Find a picnic spot and have lunch. Toilets can be found near the Coach Park and in the Courtyard.
12.30 - 1.00	all	Head over to the Terrace and sketch the amazing view. Can you spot Grey Stone? This stone has markings on it that date back to the Bronze Age!
1.00 - 1.30	1	Walk up to our woodland area, Sylvascope. This woodland was cleared to promote biodiversity and build our amazing treehouse.
1.00 - 1.30	2	Walk to our historic church and check out our medieval tombs that date back to the Wars of the Roses! Top tip - take a sketchbook to record what you see.
1.30 - 2.00	2	Walk up to our woodland area, Sylvascope. This woodland was cleared to promote biodiversity and build our amazing treehouse.
1.30 - 2.00	1	Walk to our historic church and check out our medieval tombs that date back to the Wars of the Roses! Top tip - take a sketchbook to record what you see.
2.00 - 2.20	all	Play on our Adventure Playground and visit the toilets in the Courtyard.
2.20 - 2.30	all	Walk up to the Coach Park, visit the toilets and prepare to leave.
