Seating up to 32 guests, it offers a warm and atmospheric setting for celebrating with your closest friends and family

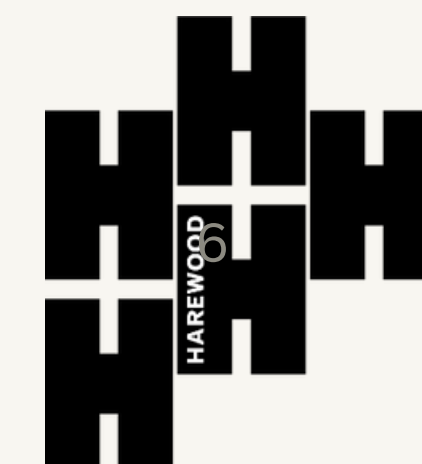

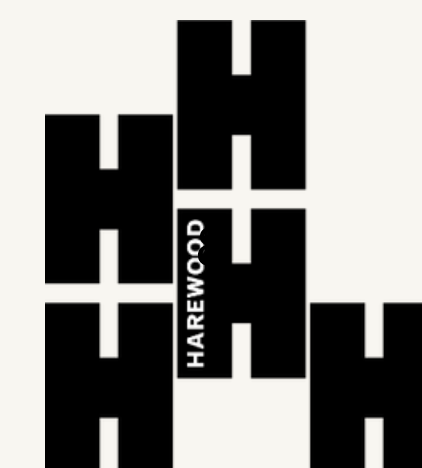


The Hovels
