Job Summary

We are looking for passionate and enthusiastic individuals to lead our new passenger wagon safari tours which are due to launch this summer. In 2026, we want to inspire our audiences by taking them on trailer tours of our parkland and wider Estate, revealing the many layers of Harewood's historical landscape and exploring our rich flora and fauna. Visitors will get to experience up close our native wildlife and farm animals and learn about our approach to conservation and sustainability. The role involves towing the purpose built passenger wagon across the Harewood Estate, hitching and un-hitching the wagon, performing pre and post-tour safety checks and ensuring tours run in a timely manner.

We have range of hours available from 4 to 18 hours per week from the 23rd July to the 5th September 2026.

KEY RESULT AREAS

- Safely tow and manoeuvre visitors across our park and wider estate by driving the vehicle and towing the passenger wagon.
- Travel on the passenger wagon whilst giving a scripted tour sharing, interesting facts and knowledge about the Harewood Estate (we'll provide you with all of the interesting information).
- Ensure the visitor experience is delivered to the very highest of standards and adhere to timings.
- Following daily opening and closing procedures are appropriate.
- Perform pre-trip and post-trip inspections.
- Observe and report any incidents immediately, which may affect the tour, other team members or visitors.
